

Boardwalk Redevelopment Fact Sheet

21 December 2009

- On 22 December 2009, the Premier of Queensland, Anna Bligh announced the new Boardwalk designs.
- The Boardwalk redevelopment is expected to commence in February 2010.
- The new Boardwalk precinct will provide the Brisbane community with approximately 70 metres of new prime riverfront public space.
- The design will also include a new adventure playground for children and quality waterfront restaurants and cafés.
- As part of the Corporation's commitment to create new green space, it will develop no more than 2,000m² gross floor area contained to a commercial building envelope of 1,000m².
- The redevelopment will deliver open green lawns, and will lay the foundation for a better connection between Clem Jones Promenade and the Goodwill Bridge, and the ability to interact directly with the Brisbane River.
- The Corporation advertised the proposed amendments to the Approved Development Plan on Tuesday 15 September, 2009 in the Courier Mail.
- Details of the proposed development were made available for public inspection and comment at the South Bank Visitor Centre in Stanley Street Plaza until 5pm on Tuesday 29 September, 2009.
- After reviewing submissions, the proposed ADP amendments were gazetted on 18 December 2009.
