SUBJECT: Vehicle Access

Access

Delivery vehicle access into the Parklands is permitted from Midnight to 9:30am each day with the exception of the Sidon St (Park Avenue) entrance which is between 07:00am and 9:30am daily. Vehicles are not permitted south of the Tribune St entrance prior to 7:00am each day.

Bollards control the access points and are only left open between the hours outlined above. The Russell St and Tribune St entrances have pneumatic bollards that are operated remotely from Security Control. These two access points also have intercoms that are linked directly to the Security Control Room.

Vehicle access into the parklands is as follows:

- Russell St (Cultural Forecourt) – provides access via the Clem Jones Promenade
- Ernest St (Stanley St Plaza) – provides access to Stanley St Plaza and the Central Cafes
- Tribune St – provides access to the Arbour Cafes and the Boardwalk (via the Clem Jones Promenade)
- Sidon St (Park Avenue) provides access to the Park Avenue complex loading bay and the Boardwalk.

Vehicles onsite during the permitted times are only allowed to stand for a maximum of 20 minutes to load/unload. If this period is to be extended, an Onsite Vehicle Permit is to be issued.

Outside Delivery Times

After 9:30am vehicles are not permitted onsite to make deliveries unless prior arrangements are made with South Bank Corporation. An Onsite Vehicle Permit is required for any vehicle that is onsite for an extended period of time. During busy periods all vehicle movements are to be escorted by South Bank Staff or Security. Site Rules

- Hazard lights must be on when driving onsite
- Vehicles are only drive on designated pathways
- Under no circumstances may any vehicle be driven or parked on the turf or in garden areas
- Maximum speed 15kph
- Vehicles must give way to pedestrians and cyclists at all times
- Vehicles must not block any footpath or pathway
- Any damage caused by the vehicle must be reported to Security Control on 3867 2045 before the vehicle is removed from site
