

## Stage 1 of Grey Street Improvement works begin!

This week South Bank Corporation commenced stage 1 of works which is the first of a four-stage program of upgrades to Grey Street (between Tribune Street and Ernest Street). These works will deliver important safety improvements for all road users and pedestrians, as well as improve the streetscape along the median of Grey Street.



WHERE: Grey Street (between Vulture Street and Russell Street). WHEN: April – July 2023 (in 4 stages) STAGE 1 WORKS:

- Location: Grey Street (between Tribune and Ernest Streets)
- Dates: 17 April 19 May 2023
- Time: 6am 3pm, Monday Friday daily (no weekend works)
- **Road Closures:** Grey Street southbound lane closed (between Tribune and Ernest Streets). Detour via Little Stanley Street

### STAGE 1 WORKS WILL INVOLVE

- Median lighting: replacement of street lights in the centre median and installation of uplights at the base of each Kauri Pine tree.
- **Landscaping:** dedicated pedestrian crossing paths, irrigation and planting of new sub-tropical plants within the road median.
- Footpath upgrades to sections outside retail tenancies.
