

## Grey Street Improvement Works: Stage 1 Until Friday 12 May 2023

## Stage 1 of the Grey Street Safety Improvement works, between Tribune Street and Ernest Street are well underway.

**UPDATE:** The footpath upgrade works outside retail tenancies (Shysh, Bourbon St / Harajuku, and Bake N Grill) scheduled to take place in mid May, will now occur after the Truck Show (15 - 22 May). Stakeholders will be notified ahead of these works commencing.

## SCHEDULE OF UPCOMING WORKS:

Tuesday 2 May – Friday 12 May:	The following works are scheduled to occur, between Monday and Friday, 6am – 3pm daily:
	<ul> <li>Median landscaping</li> <li>Irrigation and soil works to be finalised.</li> <li>Pedestrian pathways setout / formwork to be installed.</li> <li>Planting to commence.</li> </ul>
15 May – 22 May:	No works scheduled due to South Bank Truck Show.
<b>ROAD CLOSURES</b> ongoing throughout Stage 1	<ul> <li>Grey Street south bound lane (between Tribune St and Ernest St) remains only accessible to authorised vehicles during construction works hours (6am - 3pm, Monday to Friday) to maintain safety - Detour via Little Stanley Street.</li> <li>Grey Street north bound lane to remain open at all times.</li> <li>South Bank Carpark resident and visitor access to retail tenancies to remain open at all times.</li> <li>Traffic control in place at all times during the works.</li> </ul>
<b>IMPACTS</b> ongoing throughout Stage 1	<ul><li>Trucks entering and exiting site frequently.</li><li>Some noise will occur, with mechanical equipment.</li><li>Markets to be held in Stanley Plaza.</li></ul>
